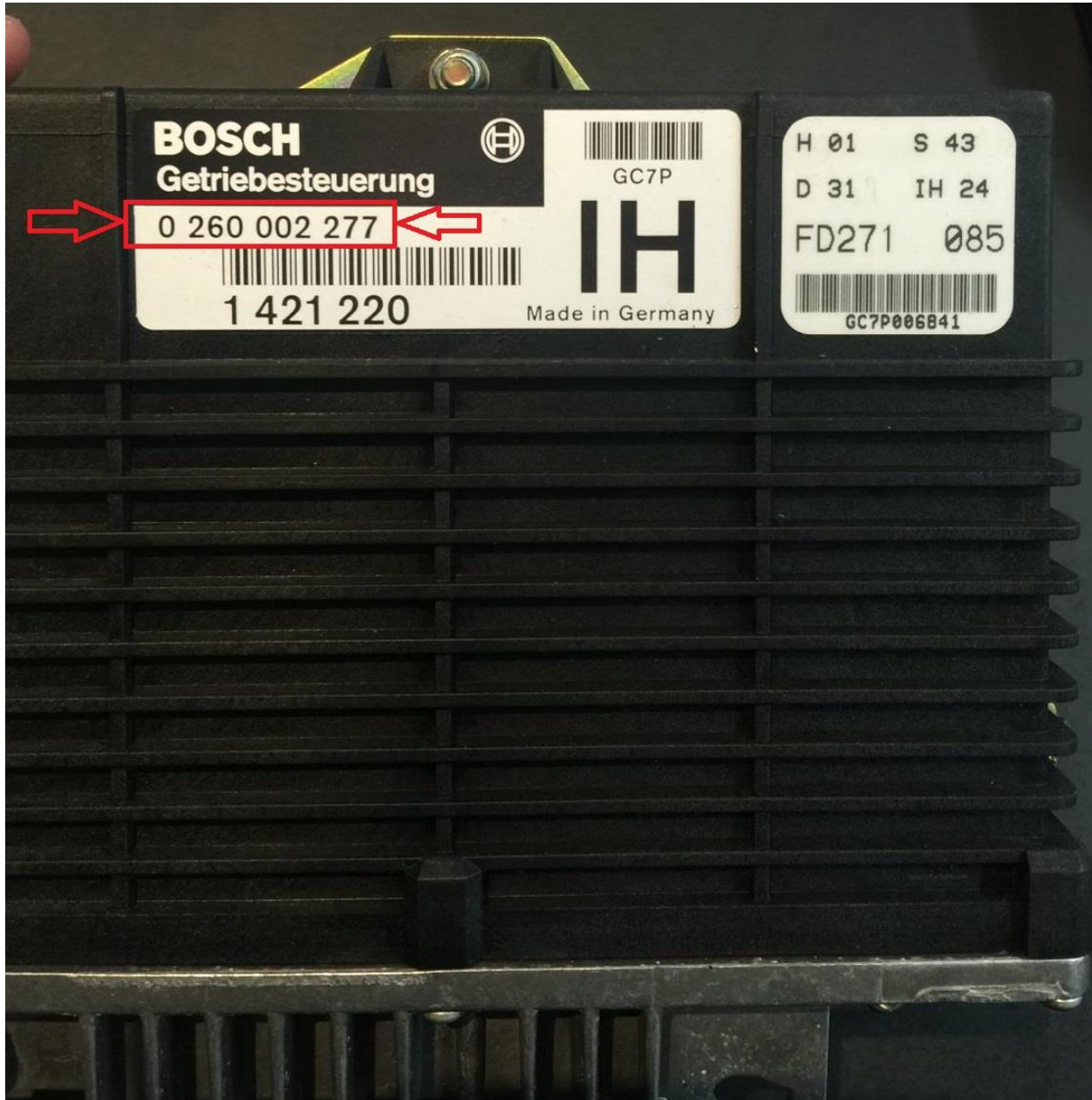




To ensure the correct chip(s) are ordered for your vehicle Dinan will require some information off the control units of the vehicle. See below for descriptions and example pictures of the information Dinan needs off the TCU and ECU (DME) for the identifying purposes.

Transmission Control unit (TCU)

There is a sticker with a barcode located on the outside of the TCM. Dinan needs the 10 digit number directly above the barcode. This number always starts with 0 260 xxx xxx. See Below example:





Engine control unit (DME)

There is a sticker located in the left lower corner of the DME which has 5 lines of information with the top line containing the VIN. Dinan needs the bottom three lines that each contain 7 digits. The most important line in the last line. See red arrow and box.

** If the vehicle's DME has been updated there will be a white sticker with the VIN of the vehicle and update date. This will usually be located on the front of the DME but will sometimes be on the back. Dinan will need the 7 digits in lower left corner of this sticker ALONG WITH the bottom 3 lines of the original DME sticker. See blue arrow and box.
